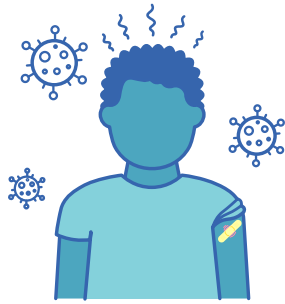


AFTER YOUR COVID-19 VACCINATION

the _____ vaccine.

This vaccine works by training your body to recognise and fight the virus that causes COVID-19. It doesn't mean you can't get COVID-19, but reduces how sick you would get from it.



Common side effects from the vaccine usually last a couple of days. Some are:

- feeling mildly sick, like you would after a flu shot
- sore arm
- headache
- fever.

These side effects are normal after getting a vaccine. If you have a side effect that worries you, please call your doctor or health clinic.



It's important to continue to keep our mob safe by

- keeping two big steps apart
- washing your hands regularly
- staying home if you're unwell.

You should still get tested if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.



You will need to book in for a second vaccination so please talk to your health care provider.
